Main Case

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.5 & 6.

The learned State counsel, on instructions states that during the investigation, the statements of petitioners have been recorded wherein they expressed that they have no apprehension to their lives and

liberty.

Heard.

Since the petitioners have expressed that there is no apprehension to their lives and liberty, however, as a matter of extreme precaution, without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-SSP, Ludhiana, to take necessary action on the representation dated 03.11.2016 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner No.1 and provide necessary protection to the petitioners in accordance with law, in case he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.5 & 6.
