ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

This is a petition filed by the petitioners seeking regular bail in FIR No. 93 dated 05.08.2016 registered at Police Station Sangat District Bathinda under Section 306 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that Kuldeep Kaur had been married over 8 years and had two children and there are no allegations of instigation or abetment nor it is the case of demand of dowry and the complainant had mentioned that the family was pressurizing them to vacate the house. He further contends that the complainant is a retired police official and has named the Devar and Devarani whereas the dispute was with the husband and the allegations were that he was having illicit relations.

Petitioners are the Devar and Devarani and the investigation is over.

Challan has been presented. There are no allegations of abetment or instigation in the FIR. The prosecution will lead evidence in this regard.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
