JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.84 dated 31.08.2016, under Sections 379-B/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Concededly, petitioner was arrested in this case on 1st September, 2016 and after subjecting him to custodial interrogation, he was remanded to judicial custody, meaning thereby, he was not required by the police for further interrogation.

On conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented. The only point raised by learned State counsel is that there is another case of similar nature pending against the petitioner. In the given facts and circumstances, it would not be justifiable to decline him the bail, especially, in the circumstance that the conclusion of the trial would certainly take sufficient long time.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
