JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.129 dated 13.09.2014, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at P.S. Sadar, Distt. Kapurthala.

Heard.

Short affidavit of Superintendent, Central Jail, Jalandhar at Kapurthala, dated 15.12.2016, filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, the petitioner is a known case of Hepatitis 'C'. He was referred to Civil Hospital, Kapurthala, for investigation. It has been further noticed that in view of the health condition, the petitioner requires better treatment for which the matter is scheduled to be referred to some higher institute. The reply suggests that the petitioner requires better

health facilities which are not available with the jail authorities.

In view of the above, the Court is inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioner on health grounds for a period of three months from the date of his release, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender back to the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
