After arguing at some length, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas before the trial court at appropriate stage. He, however, submits that petitioner is a resident of Delhi and the trial is proceeding at Jhajjar, his personal appearance before the trial court may, therefore, be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioner moves an application for exemption of his personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petition on such terms and conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioner may be allowed to appear through his counsel except on the dates his presence is necessary.
