Petitioner while on bail, during pendency of the trial absented on 05.11.2015 when two prosecution witnesses were present.

Perusal of order dated 05.11.2015 passed by the trial Court indicates that the petitioner had come present after his bail bonds had been cancelled as such he was ordered to be taken in custody and sent to judicial custody.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 05.11.2015.

I have considered the legality and propriety of order dated 05.11.2015.

The order of cancelling bail appears to be apparently a harsh order.

Since the petitioner has put in appearance on the date of hearing, he can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety for the same amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
