As a member of unlawful assembly, the petitioner, along with his co-accused, had allegedly fired a gun shot at Rakesh. No injury, however, was caused to Rakesh.

An affidavit of Rakesh having been placed on record, regarding the petitioner having not fired at him and taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner, i.e. w.e.f. 05.10.2016, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be

released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal.
