This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7 and not harass and pressurize the petitioner to compromise the matter with accused persons in FIR No. 187 dated 23.05.2016 registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 295-A and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police Amritsar, District Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 04.10.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police Amritsar, District Amritsar is directed to decide the representation dated 04.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
