By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.271, dated 18.12.2006, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 19.11.2015, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and furnished bail/surety bonds.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has surrendered and he has been admitted to bail by the trial Court.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.11.2015, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
