Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Gurpinder Singh in case FIR No.83 dated 25.11.2015, under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

As per the allegations, on the date of occurrence on 22.11.2015 at around 12.00 Noon, the petitioner-accused along with co-accused parents are alleged to have entered the house of the complainant and inflicted injuries upon her son-Sukhjinder Singh.

The role attributed to the present petitioner is of lalkara and a blunt blow of *Kulhari* at the forehead of the injured-Sukhjinder.

It was contended that the said injury has been opined to be simple in nature and the only non bailable offence is under Section 452 IPC, which otherwise is not made out as the house is owned by the grandfather of the petitioner. It was further contended that the dispute is between family members.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Manjinder Singh, submits that the said injury has been found to be grievous in nature and the offence under Section 325, IPC has been added, which otherwise is bailable offence. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 04.02.2016, is made absolute.
