Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record copy of 'Adhar' card (Annexure P-1) wherein his birth year is mentioned as 1991 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record copy of 'Adhar' card (Annexure P-2) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 11.10.1999. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

As per copy of 'Adhar' card (Annexure P-2), petitioner No.2 is 17 years old.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and without

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saying anything regarding the age of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
