JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 3rd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.112 dated 10.11.2012 for the offences punishable under Sections 15, 25, 60, 61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa (**Annexure P-1**).

There is a recovery of 81 Kgs. of *Poppy Husk* from the possession of three accused including the present petitioner/accused, which quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 10.11.2012 and the trial has not been concluded.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Mehar Singh, submits that only 01 out of 07 prosecution witnesses has been examined and the next date fixed is 17.03.2016.

The petitioner is also stated to have been convicted in two other FIRs under the NDPS Act.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court concerned is directed to conclude the trial within two months from the next date of hearing.
