FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 19.04.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Abohar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Baljeet Singh, injured Manjeet Kaur and the accused persons namely Iqbal Singh, Prem Singh, Harbans Singh, Sona Singh, Krishan Singh, Ghakku Singh @ Baldev Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that parties belong to the same very village and the offences for which

the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.84 dated 29.09.2012 registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka under Sections 324/323/148/149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
