JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 174, dated 22.10.2007 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Quadian, District Gurdaspur along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated October 29, 2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated November 19, 2015, report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, has been

received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free pressure, voluntary or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 174, dated 22.10.2007 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Quadian, District Gurdaspur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
