This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.119 dated 09.08.2016 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station-Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bhatinda.

As per the allegations, the petitioner had defrauded the complainant by getting Rs. 7,70,000/- on the pretext of getting admission of complainant's daughter in Punjab Agriculture University Ludhiana and also to get her job but

could do neither. The petitioner also issued cheque for the amount of Rs.

7,70,000/- which bounced.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has been in custody since 07.09.2016 and it is a case of magisterial trial. Challan has been presented.

Learned DAG on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
