Though the allegations against the petitioners are serious, in view of the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation, they can be granted the concession of bail. A separate FIR No. 68 dated 07.09.2016 under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 225, 212, 216, 148, 149 IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act has also been registered at Police Station Daramgarh, Sangrur against the petitioners wherein the petitioners have been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to a condition that petitioners will join

investigation, as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation, in any manner.
