INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Harpreet Singh, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.206 dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, Daljit Singh by using power of attorney of Sant Singh, who already expired on 06.05.2004, executed sale deed in favour of his son i.e. present petitioner. Sant Singh was the maternal uncle of Daljit Singh and due to this reason, the factum of his death was in the knowledge of accused. There are allegations that the present petitioner along with co-accused

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connived in forging and fabricating the sale deed by using power of attorney of a dead person.

As the petitioner is a beneficiary in the sale deed and it was in his knowledge that Sant Singh has already expired, therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
