Petitioner is alleged to have broken the lock of the shed of complainant, Randhir Singh and stolen away the instruments of tractor. The complainant has named the petitioner as Lalli Ram in the FIR.

The theft was allegedly committed in March, 2016 whereas the FIR has been registered after six months. Identity and culpability of the petitioner will certainly be a debatable issue, especially when no recovery has been effected.

Petitioner having joined investigation, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 10.11.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
