JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to safeguard the lives and liberty of the petitioners as they have solemnized the marriage against the wishes of respondents No. 4 and 5.

On instructions from SI Dilbagh Singh, learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of notice of motion issued by this Court, the police approached respondents No. 4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.1- Manpreet Kaur) and they have stated that the petitioners are major and their daughter has solemnized her marriage with her own free-will and consent with Gurpreet Singh, regarding which, they have no grudge. Similarly, statements of Manpreet Kaur as well as Gurpreet Singh- petitioners have also been recorded, according to which, there is no

apprehension to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 as they have no objection to their marriage and further that they do not require any sort of protection.

3. In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is disposed of as such.
