While on bail in a case of recovery of 55 grams of diphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner absented on 11.05.2015 when his bail bonds were cancelled. The petitioner voluntarily surrendered in the Court on 21.09.2015. Period of about five months has elapsed, the petitioner has been in custody.

Taking into consideration the conduct of the petitioner of having voluntarily surrendered, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail as the period of detention will certainly have a deterrent effect upon the petitioner not to absent himself again without any sufficient cause.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
