Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Prem Chand, alleging that the complainant had loaded mustard oil in the tanker driven by the petitioner valuing ₹18,59,161/- which was to be transported to Harlalka Manufacturing Enterprises, Assam but the petitioner sold the oil and misappropriated the other articles.

Counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the application by contending that the petitioner has committed a serious offence causing wrongful loss to the complainant.

After hearing learned counsel for the complainant and the State counsel and going through the record, it transpires that the recovery has already been effected. The petitioner has been in custody since 25.09.2016; the trial is likely to take a long time, as such the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
