On the instructions of ASI Mohan Lal, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation.

The allegations against the petitioner is that he had facilitated the preparation of forged jamabandi by his co-accused Balbir Singh who had applied for a loan on the basis of forged revenue record.

Perusal of the police file indicates that the petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of his telephonic conversation with Tehsildar admitting his fault.

No other corroborative material appears to have been collected connecting the petitioner with the crime.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation, he can be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 20.11.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C and subject to with an additional condition that he will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.
