Heard learned counsel for the rival parties at length and perused the FIR as well as order dated 02.11.2015.

A perusal of the FIR itself clearly shows that the petitioner was paid an amount of ₹27 lacs at Tarn Taran. Petitioner has been specifically named in the FIR as the person accepted the amount with the promise to have admission in the medical college abroad.

In my opinion, the petitioner is not entitled to any relief in the form of anticipatory bail since there is prima-facie material available against him. Investigation is must and custodial interrogation is obviously necessary in such case.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 30.11.2015 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is vacated.

Petition stands dismissed, accordingly.
