Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.250 dated 18.07.2014, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, Police Station Chherretta, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not come today.

The record shows that he was not present even on last date nor he had paid the amount to the complainant as was directed. On the last date it had been stated that the petitioner could not come as his mother had suffered a heart attack and was admitted in the hospital.

The State counsel states that the gold articles were not recovered.

Recovery is yet to be effected. Considering his conduct, the petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail. The petition is dismissed.
