Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is being harassed by respondent No.6 on the asking of respondent No.5 with whom the petitioner has a dispute regarding land though they are related to each other. He further states that in order to seek protection of his life and liberty, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 21.10.2016 (Annexure P-4) to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 is directed to look into the contents of said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
