INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Sonu alias Manjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.146 dated 02.06.2016 registered at Police Station Kunjpura, District Karnal, under Sections 302, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per prosecution version the petitioner was sitting as pillion rider on the motorcycle which was being driven by Ankush (since deceased) and he gave gun shot on the back side of the neck of Ankush. The present petitioner is the main accused in the case.

Moreover, the complainant has not been examined so far. Therefore, there is

every chance that the petitioner can temper with the evidence, if he is released on bail at this stage.

Therefore, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I do not find any merit in this petition.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
