On asking of the Court, Mr.Neeraj Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a witness in a criminal case registered against respondent No.7 and on account of that, he is being threatened by private respondents. He will be satisfied if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to look into the representation Annexure P-1

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation (Annexure P-1).
