The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Neeraj Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.4 is the real son of the petitioner but he and his sons have been disinherited by the petitioner from her property and now for that reason, she is being threatened by them. Learned counsel further submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police,

Patiala is directed to look into the representation Annexure P-1 given by the petitioner for protection of her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation (Annexure P-1).
