Report dated 11.12.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patti has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Joginder Singh, Shamsheer Singh @ Sher Singh and Mukhtiar Singh as well as of complainant Jasbir Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.219 dated 07.12.2011 under Sections 447, 434, 511 IPC, Police Station, Patti District Tarn Taran and all other consequential proceedings arising

therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
