INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Paramdeep Singh @ Paramjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 16.08.2016, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Gurdaspur, under Sections 324, 323, 326, 148 and 149 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with *kirpan* and has caused injuries on the head and right leg of the complainant which have been declared grievous in nature.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present

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case and in view of the facts that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and weapon used for commission of offence is yet to be recovered from him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
