Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Mohammad Aarif Hussain Ansari and Sahid Thekedar in case FIR No.312 dated 13.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 409, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 13(1)(c) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

As per the case of the prosecution, the driver of the private contractor/petitioner no.2 was apprehended carrying 91 pipes belonging to the Department of Public Health and on his disclosure statement it was revealed that both the petitioners were involved in transporting the said

pipes from godown for selling the same in UP. The explanation tendered by the petitioner is that the pipes were being transported from the godown to construction site and as certified by the XEN concerned. Reference to documents Annexures P-7 to P-9 has been made.

It is further submitted that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Devinder Kumar submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 03rd of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
