Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Criminal Complaint No.779/2013 dated 5.12.2013 titled as "Jal Singh vs. Bhajan Lal", under Sections 418, 420, 409, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Palwal.

This Court vide order dated 20.11.2015, while issuing notice of motion, directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of ten days and in case, he surrenders before the trial Court, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bond to the

satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 20.11.2015, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 27.11.2015 and has been admitted on interim bail by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal vide order dated 27.11.2015.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 20.11.2015 are made absolute.
