Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.181 dated 7.11.2015, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of both the parties and reported that the parties have entered into a compromise voluntarily, free from any duress or inducement.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.181 dated 7.11.2015, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
