Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during pendency of trial in case FIR No.11 dated 24.2.2011, under Sections 25(1)/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid offence, the petitioner is in custody since 17.9.2015 and the police has submitted the supplementary challan but charges have not been framed.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate and states that there is another FIR bearing No.15/16, under Section 110 Cr.P.C., P.S. Majitha, Amritsar is pending against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The allegation against the petitioner is for commission of offence under Sections 25(1)/54/59 of the Arms Act. He is in custody since 17.9.2015 and the trial in the case will take sufficient time. Accordingly, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.
