JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the lives, liberty and properties of the petitioners as well as their family members at the hands of respondents No.6 to 9 alongwith some other unidentified persons who are trying to throw them out from the residential accommodation/huts where they are living for the last 25/26 years.

2. Notice to respondents No.2 to 4, only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that despite the fact that various representations including representation/complaint dated September 19, 2015 (Annexure P-10) have been made to respondent No.4 as

well as to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken. He also place on record certain photographs showing the existence of huts. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is given to respondents No.3 and 4 to consider their representations made by them including latest representation Annexure P-10 and take appropriate action.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No-3-Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Gurdaspur as well as to respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, Punjab to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representations Annexures P-8 and P-9 including latest representation Annexure P-10 and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
