The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 189 dated 06.12.2008 registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur under Section 498-A IPC.

The petitioner had been declared proclaimed offender in July 2009. That order was challenged in CRM No. M-28255 of 2015. This Court had directed the petitioner to return to India by 31.01.2016 and file an application for pre-arrest bail. The petitioner had pleaded that he came to India and had filed an application before the Additional Sessions Judge but his application was dismissed.

On the last date of hearing, it had been stated that the petitioner had returned to India before the date that was given, therefore, notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Today it is stated that petitioner had not returned and is still abroad. It appears that a false claim was made in the petition.

The petitioner is not entitled to any relief.

The petition is dismissed.
