Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 20.3.2013, registered under Sections 382, 41 IPC, at Police Station Cantt., District Bathinda, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bathinda received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the parties and has reported that the parties have amicably resolved the matter without any threat, coercion or pressure. Photocopies of the statements of the parties have also been enclosed with the report.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.18 dated 20.3.2013, registered under Sections 382, 41 IPC, at Police Station Cantt., District Bathinda, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.
