The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 62 dated 10.05.2015, under Sections 307, 411/34 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station, Mohana, District Sonapat.

Heard the submissions made by Mr. Bijender Dhankar, Advocate representing the petitioner and Mr. Karan Sharma, Asst. A.G., Haryana representing the State.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Co-accused Bhupender and Virender have already been allowed bail by learned trial Court. The petitioner is in custody since 11.05.2015 and the trial will still take some time to complete.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Jai Kishan Chhillar, Superintendent, District Prison, Sonapat giving details of custody of the petitioner in the instant case. On instructions from SI

Surender Kumar, learned counsel for State submits that all public witnesses including complainant, injured and eye witnesses have been examined and now only the formal witnesses are left to be examined.

Considering the fact that the trial is still likely to take some time to complete and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody, he is admitted to regular bail during pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
