Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. by Jaswant Singh @ Azad seeking transfer the investigation of FIR No.184, dated 17.11.2013, under Sections 120-B/121/121/A of IPC, under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and under Sections 10/13/17/18/20/40 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar City, Punjab to any independent agency like CBI or NIA.

As is evident from the status report dated September 1, 2015, the investigation has already been completed and final report

under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, against the petitioner and his co-accused – Balwant Singh etc. The petitioner is also facing the said trial and is appearing before the trial Court.

In view of submission of report, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is disposed of as such. However, it is made clear that petitioner shall be at liberty to take all the pleas/points which have been taken in this petition before the learned trial Court at the appropriate time and stage.
