The instant petitioner has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for summoning and passing orders/directions against SSP, District Amritsar (Rural), Punjab as he has failed to look into the grievances referred in the representation of the petitioner raised vide representation dated 01.09.2015 and not having found any substance for appropriate action as per law within a period of two months.

The brief facts of the case are that daughter of the petitioner i.e. Sandeep Kaur was enticed away by Bachhiter Singh on the pretext of marriage. As a matter of fact, Bachhiter Singh is a married person and having wife and two children who also gave a false affidavit that he is not married and this is his first marriage, at the time of grant of protection vide order dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner has made representation to the police dated 01.09.2015 (Annexure P-1A) with the prayer mentioned above but no action has been taken in this regard by the respondents No.1 and 2.

directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to look into the representation dated 01.09.2015 (Annexure P-1A) and take action in accordance with law.
