The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to hand over the investigation of the case First Information Report No.95 dated 29.8.2016 registered under Sections 302, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar to Central Bureau of Investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Neeraj Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in a complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. made by the petitioner, on the direction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ajnala the instant First

Information Report was registered against respondents No. 4 to 7. The police is not taking any action against the accused respondents No.4 to 7 because they are very influential persons. He further submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is directed to look into the representation Annexure P-4 given by the petitioner.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the representation (Annexure P-4).
