Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the respondents No.2 to 4 to investigate the case FIR No.377 dated 24.09.2016 (Annexure P/2), under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station 'A' Division Amritsar City, District Amritsar and to summon/arrest the accused i.e. respondents No.6 to 9 whose names appeared in the FIR, but no action has been taken against them.

Heard.

The respondent No.2-Police Commissioner, Amritsar is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-5) only for the purpose of protecting the petitioner from the threats given by the private respondents. He is directed to make necessary enquiry and if he/she satisfies that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner from the private respondents then to take necessary steps as per law and pass appropriate order within one month, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

So far as, the fact that the investigation is not conducted properly for the purpose of arrest of the private respondents is concern of, the petitioner is at liberty to avail alternative remedy by applying before the Illaqa Magistrate, who has ample power to monitor the investigation as per law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others 2008(1) RCR (Criminal) 392*.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
