JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the five petitioners, namely, Mania @ Veena, Raju, Jonny, Khaniya Lal and Bobby in case FIR No.165 dated 15.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 448, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station E Division, Amritsar.

The allegations of the complainant Kewal Krishan are that on 7.9.2015 at around 4.00 pm, the petitioners committed trespass over the property in question and tried to raise construction in spite of the stay order passed by the trial Court. They are also alleged to have taken away certain

articles from the site.

It is contended that the petitioners are residing in the property in question, being an evacuee property since time immemorial and a false case has been registered against them after a delay of 08 days in a bid to grab the property in question by the complainant and his family members. As regards the violation of the interim order in the suit for permanent injunction the petitioners are facing separate proceedings under Order 39 Rule 2-A of CPC.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submit that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Narain Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 26th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
