HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 12.6.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Abohar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody in case FIR No.80/2015, for offence under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Khuian Sarwar and, therefore, he is unable to place on record the compromise as well as the Registration Certificate (RC) of the truck in question i.e. bearing registration No.RJ-07G-7618(10 tyres). However, he further

submits that in view of the reply submitted by Gurbhej Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Abohar, District-Fazilka, the truck in question may be released or handed over to him.

As per the said reply submitted by respondents No. 1 and 2 the petitioner has parked the truck in question outside the Police Station Khuian Sarwar with a malafide intention and instead of taking the truck in question in spite of being asked by the police officials many times, he has not taken away the truck in question

Accordingly, without advert to the controversy involved, but in view of the said reply submitted by respondents No. 1 and 2, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to take away the truck in question parked outside the Police Station Khuian Sarwar, subject to the presentation of Registration Certificate (RC) of the truck in question.
