This is a petition for quashing of a private complaint filed by respondent Jaswant Singh pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise with the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners informs that after summoning, the charges have been framed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considered the contentions in the light of judgment of “**Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052**”.

Since the petitioners claim that the complainant has compromised the matter and is ready to make a statement in this context, I dispose of this petition with a direction that the trial Court shall record the statement of the complainant regarding the matter having been compromised on the date fixed or on any day convenient to the Court. If on the basis of the statement of the complainant and the petitioners, the trial Court is satisfied that the matter has been compromised amicably

without any threat, coercion or undue influence, it will be open to the trial Court to dismiss the complaint on the statement of complainant Jaswant Singh to that effect. The trial Court shall permit the complainant and would be entitled to permit compounding on the basis of compromise, following the above said judgment.
