The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.129, dated 19.8.2016, registered under Sections 307, 323, 427, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has

been in custody for the past more than 3 months and is not attributed any

role in causing any injury.

Counsel for the complainant states that the petitioner is a hardened criminal. Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, states that though it is correct that the petitioner is a hardened criminal yet it is her duty to inform the Court that even the complainant is also a hardened criminal.

Be that as it may, in view of the nature offence and without commenting upon the merits of the case, as well as keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
