The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail in case based on First Information Report No.17 dated 27.02.2016 under Sections 302, 364, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short IPC) registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala.

It is submitted by Mr. Aakash Singla, Advocate representing the complainant as well as learned State counsel that the statement of the complainant has been recorded and the father of the deceased has been given up as unnecessary by the prosecution.

Learned State counsel also submits that only some official witnesses are left to be examined.

In view of the above facts and circumstances and without going into the merits, as the trial is still likely to take some time to complete and there is no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody,

he is ordered to be released on regular bail during pendency of the trial,
on his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
