Petitioner claims to be a widow being harassed by her in laws claiming that she had been assaulted and her house was trespassed on 8.7.2016. An FIR appears to have also been registered, a copy of which has been placed on record as Annexure P2. Civil litigation regarding the property in dispute is also apparently pending.

Through the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, for taking legal action against respondent nos.4 to 6.

I have heard the counsel for the petitioner and gone through all the documents appended with the petition as well as the complaint. Legal action regarding specific occurrence dated 3.10.2016, has already been taken by registering FIR Annexure P2.

It is claimed that life and liberty of the petitioner be protected.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the property dispute between the petitioner and her in-laws and regarding the conduct of any party on account of controversy existing amongst the family members, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case on the information of the petitioner, it transpires that any cognisable offence has been committed and that there is genuine apprehension of breach of peace, the concerned police official shall impartially look into the matter and take action, if any, in accordance with law.
