Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to take action on the representations of the petitioner and conduct an enquiry against respondents no.4 to 6.

The allegation against respondents no.4 to 6 is that they are harassing and interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioner and his family and are also issuing threats of life to them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhupinder Singh, submits that the matter has been enquired into by Mr. Deepak Hilori, IPC, A.C.P., West, Amritsar City and it has been found that the allegations made in the complaint/representations are civil in nature, as various litigations are pending between the parties. He has also filed the enquiry report in Court which is taken on record. A copy of the same has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the fact that since an enquiry has already been conducted into the matter, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
