JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought the concession of bail, pending trial, in case FIR No.334 dated 25.08.2016, under Section 436 of IPC registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, Sonapat.

Concededly, petitioner was arrested in this case on 30th August, 2016. On conclusion of the investigation, challan has already been presented in the Court and the trial Court is seized of the matter. Moreover, Sajjan Kumar, an alleged eye-witness, has already been examined by the prosecution but he did not toe the line of the prosecution subsequently, he has been declared hostile. The author of an FIR-complainant was not present at the scene of occurrence. Moreover, the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sufficient long time.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration and the fact that the disposal of the trial would take sufficient long time, this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period. Accordingly, petition

is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bond(s) at the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
